

BETHANY BIRCHES CAMP DRESS GUIDELINES

We ask that campers and staff follow these guidelines in order to help all of us focus on a positive camp experience. The guidelines are intended to avoid provocative or disruptive attire and reflect the camp's Christian values of respect, modesty and community.

All campers and staff are expected to:

- Wear appropriate footwear for all activities (sneakers, hiking shoes/boots, sandals – MUST HAVE HEEL STRAP...no flip-flops)
- Wear a modest bathing suit at swim time (one-piece for female)
- Be clothed in attire which does not distract others from a positive camp experience. The following are examples of clothes that distract:
 - * exposed undergarments
 - * excessively tight or short garments (shirts and shorts)
 - * strapless or spaghetti strap shirts
 - * mesh or see-through material
 - * bare midriff (shirts and pants should overlap)
 - * any attire which exposes cleavage or appears to have a provocative nature
 - * pajamas worn other than at bedtime

All campers and staff are expected to refrain from wearing:

- Any attire which appears to promote:
 - * alcohol
 - * tobacco
 - * any illegal substance
- Any attire which contains messages/illustrations:
 - * with lewd, defamatory, obscene or vulgar references
 - * which intimidates or ridicules any person or group of people
 - * which promotes violence

The Directors and counselors are granted the authority to provide guidance in the choice of attire when needed.
